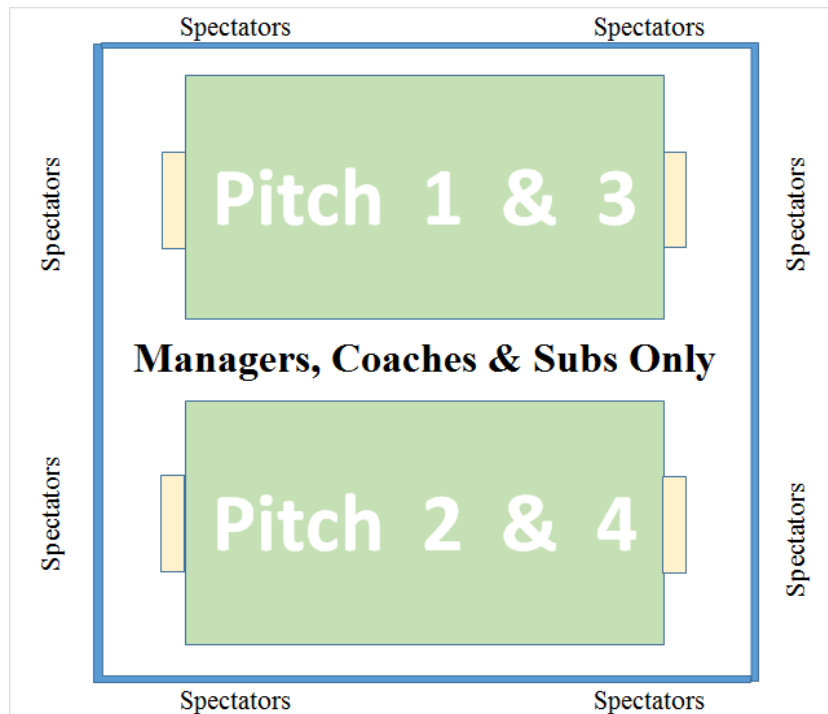


| Hazard | Controls in place | Risk Factor | Comment |
|---------------------------------|---|-------------|--|
| Weather | In the event of extreme weather such as high winds, thunder and lightning etc., the tournament organisers may suspend or cancel the tournament as deemed appropriate | Low | Use Grandstands and club house for shelter |
| Goals | All the mini soccer goals are inspected prior to the tournament to ensure they are complete and safe, the goals are firmly anchored in position using 'u' shaped metal stakes The nets and goalposts have no dangerous hooks or fastenings | Low | Goals to size and design as approved by County FA |
| Pitches | Before the tournament the event organisers will check the pitches and as far as possible make safe any dangerous holes and remove any dangerous objects | Medium | Visual check to be carried out by the organisers |
| Pitch Side Barriers | The pitches will have a spectator barrier in line with recent FA respect guidelines. The distance from the touchline will be realistic to ensure an area safe for players, match officials and spectators. | Low | The event will use the FA-endorsed Respect Zone Barrier Kit At the Dovecote, Players, Managers, Coaches, Substitutes and match officials are the only people allowed beyond the barriers |
| Conduct of Players | The tournament organisers will appoint a referee to control each match and he/she has the authority to send off any player guilty of dangerous play and or physical violence | Medium | If a player is sent off they can play no further part in the tournament as stated in the tournament handbook rules |
| Footwear, shin pads and jewelry | The referee will require all players to be suitably attired. Shin pads must be worn as required by the handbook rules. Wearing of jewelry and unsuitable footwear may be prohibited by the referee if deemed dangerous | Medium | It is not possible for the referee to check every player prior to every game but will act if they notice a player is not suitably attired |
| Physical Injuries | The tournament organisers will provide first aid cover for the duration of the tournament with St Johns Ambulance or qualified First Aid Volunteers The tournament is covered by the club's injury insurance policy | Medium | There is ambulance access to the pitches via Hind Leys College car park or The Dovecote Football Stadium Copy of Club and Tournament Insurance available on request from Secretary |
| Dehydration and exhaustion | Our first aid volunteers will treat any such problems. A specified tent is assigned for first aid purposes | Low | In the event of extreme heat players and their managers are responsible for rehydrating |
| Car Park | Club stewards will be on hand to guide cars to appropriate parking areas and direct adults and children from the car park to the playing areas PPE equipment and safety work ware to be supplied | Low | Owners leave their cars and valuables contained within at their own risk Managers and parents must supervise their players and young children from the car park to the playing areas |

| Grounds | Before the event thorough checks to be made of all the Dovecote facilities and grounds for safety and protection of the general public Signs to be in place for areas of danger (Do Not Enter) | Low | Covered Grandstands and club house facilities for general public use Any people entering these areas do so at their own risk |
| Refreshments | All areas to have Health & Safety and Hygiene Checks before and during the tournament Signs and Barriers to be in place before the gates are open to the general public Serving area to be away from hot drink preparation Food Safety Any waste or rubbish to have designated areas of safety | Low Medium Low Medium | Serving staff to be advised on Hygiene and food preparation Supervisors to be to on hand during the tournament to monitor and advise staff and the public Designated areas to be in place Disposables work wear and consumables to be in place Signs to be in place |
| Barbeque | All areas to have Health & Safety and Hygiene Checks before and during the tournament | Medium | As above |
| Location | Identify a safe zone on even ground Serving area to be away from cooking area (use Perimeter boarding or netting if required) Wind Direction | Medium | Designated areas to be in place Consider relocation |
| Equipment | All equipment to be checked for damage before tournament (adequate for purpose) All serving tools to be clean & serviceable | Medium low | Repair damage before tournament Hygiene Checks |
| Fuel / Hot Coals | Away from combustible items and the public Suitable area, PPE equipment and safety work ware to be supplied Any waste or rubbish to have designated areas of safety | High Medium Medium | Safe location to be identified away from serving area Warning signs and barriers to be in place Ensure safety work ware & equipment is available at all times Signs to be in place |
| Signage | Signs to be in place for staff and public information and safety | Low | Any people ignoring this information do so at their own risk |
