Before Joining The Club

The best way to contact the club is either to email coaching@shepsheddynamoyj.com or pop onto our social media channel on Facebook (Shepshed Dynamo Y&J) and drop us a message. If you know the team/age group to approach about joining the club, please use the correct contact email address. These can be found on the Shepshed Dynamo Y&J website within the team's page.

Trial Period

We want what is best for your budding young superstar, so at Shepshed Dynamo Y&J, we welcome you into the club with free taster sessions age group dependent. We want to make sure that you as a parent and your player are happy with the training content, our setup, coaches and other players. If your player is joining an already established team this trial period will be extended to ensure the player is playing at the correct ability level.

Signing Up

After your trial session, if you wish to join the club, you will be required to complete the club registration form. This form gathers the information we require to register your player with the league even if attending in a training-only capacity, if you do not wish your player to be playing competitive matches just yet. Information such as emergency contact info, medical details and kit sizing will be required, along with a digital 'Passport style' photograph. If you are 'new' to the club, we will also require proof of DOB, but we will request this separately.

Player Fees

Player fees are decided annually during committee meetings and currently range from £225 to £255, depending on the age group and number of training sessions. The fees go towards the running of the club and allow us to purchase the kits, hire training facilities (3G pitch hire is more costly), match day facilities, referee fees, insurance, specialist coaching and FA Accreditation amongst other things. A training only option is also available.

Introduction to football

Our football journey begins at the Under 6 (Year 1) age group. These fun, one-hour weekly sessions are open to both boys and girls, giving children the chance to enjoy the game, make friends, and develop early football skills. Sessions run on a **pay-as-you-play** basis, with discounts available for booking multiple sessions in advance. If a child misses a week, that session won't be deducted from their pre-paid package. At this age, we understand that children's interests and commitments can change, so we keep things flexible to suit families.

Kit Requirements

To take part, children must have:

- Shinpads (mandatory children without them will not be able to train)
- 3G-suitable footwear
- A water bottle

We also offer a **boot bag** containing preloved football boots kindly donated by other families. This is a great way for children to try out the sport without parents needing to purchase new equipment straight away.

Parental Help

The ultimate goal of the U6 group is to form a team that will join the **U7 league** the following season. To make this possible, we need at least **two parents to volunteer as coaches** for the age group (but ideally three). The club requires:

- At least one coach to hold the FA Introduction to Coaching Football qualification.
- All coaches to complete a DBS check, as well as FA safeguarding and first aid courses.
- All coaches to provide two references to support their application.

All costs for these qualifications are covered by the club.

Without this vital parental support, a team cannot be formed, and children may miss out on continuing their football journey. Many of our current coaches began their involvement this way and have since become part of the **Shepshed Dynamo Y&J family**—a truly rewarding experience.

First year of formation

Once the team is ready, it will join an official league for its first season. There are two options:

- Saturday football (YEL League)
- Sunday football (Leicestershire Mutual League)

The choice will be made by the volunteer coaches. Currently, all of our age groups—except U15s—play in the Sunday Leicestershire Leagues.

Training Sessions

Shepshed Dynamo Y&J conducts training sessions at both Iveshead School on the playing fields and Grace Dieu on their 3G pitches. The main car park for Iveshead can be accessed via Forest Street. Shepshed Dynamo Y&J aims to ensure each team conducts one training session per week during the football season. Some teams conduct additional training sessions. If this is the case, parents of those teams are informed at the start of the season. When the weather is extreme, i.e. hot summer or colder winter days, the coaches along with the Shepshed Dynamo Y&J committee will decide on whether a training session will go ahead and communicate to parents accordingly.








Grace Dieu FCV International Football Academy

Grace Dieu provides full-time academic courses for students aged 16 to 21 and has excellent football facilities as this is the home of the FCV International Football Academy.

FCV has decided to partner with Shepshed Dynamo Y&J. This partnership will provide Shepshed Dynamo Y&J with 3G training facilities to help ensure we can carry on training even through the colder/wetter seasons. Grace Dieu is located just outside of Shepshed off the A512, on Grace Dieu Manor Drive.





VEO

Shepshed Dynamo Y&J utilise the Veo system. Where possible, Shepshed Dynamo Y&J record the football matches using this system. Implementing the Veo system in grassroots football offers a myriad of benefits that significantly enhance the overall experience for players, coaches, and the entire team. The automatic recording feature eliminates the need for manual video setups, ensuring that every crucial moment of the game is captured effortlessly. With AI-powered analytics, the system provides in-depth insights into player performance, strategy effectiveness, and key match sequences. Coaches can utilise this data to tailor training sessions, identify areas for improvement, and optimise game strategies. Players benefit from personalised feedback, fostering individual growth and skill development. Moreover, the user-friendly nature of the system facilitates seamless integration into grassroots settings, empowering teams with advanced technology that was once reserved for elite levels. This not only elevates the overall quality of training and analysis but also fosters a culture of innovation and continuous improvement within grassroots football.

GK Coaching

Goalkeeper coaching is available every two weeks for both junior and senior players. Sessions are led by an FA-qualified goalkeeper coach and are tailored to suit different age groups and skill levels. Training covers core goalkeeping techniques such as shot-stopping, positioning, distribution, and communication. The programme aims to support long-term development, improve match performance, and build confidence in a structured environment.




Defibrillator

Ensuring that parents are well-informed about the location of defibrillators is of paramount importance for the safety and well-being of the players within the Shepshed Dynamo Y&J grassroots football club. In the unpredictable realm of sports, emergencies can arise unexpectedly. Immediate access to defibrillators significantly increases the chances of survival in the critical moments following a sudden cardiac event. Parents being aware of the defibrillator locations means they can act swiftly and assist not only their own children but any player in need. This proactive approach aligns with our commitment to creating a secure environment for our football community. All teams have an Emergency Action plan detailing first raiders, runners for the defibrillator and personnel to call 999.

Defibrillator Locations

There are defibrillator locations at all of the venues Shepshed Dynamo Y&J train at. Currently, training locations within the football season are Iveshead School, Grace Dieu Manor Park and the Dovecote Stadium. Below are the specific locations of the AED (automated external defibrillator) systems as well as the 'what 3 words' locations. We ask that all parents take note of these locations so that in the unfortunate event of a sudden cardiac arrest all parents are aware of the location of the AED systems.

Overview

When joining a new team or an already established team your team coach/manager will advise on the kit and sizes as these will be provided as part of the club's joining fees.

Sports Advocate

Shepshed Dynamo Y&J manages all of the football kits through Sports Advocate. Sports Advocate is a local teamwear and sports equipment specialist based in Loughborough. The kit provided by the club is to be used for 2 football seasons (2 years). If players require larger sizes of kit later in the season, it is their responsibility to purchase the required kit sizes. This kit can be purchased straight from the Sports Advocate website. In general, players tend to purchase additional gloves and rain jackets for the colder seasons.



Home Games

Home fixtures for U7s to U17s are played at Iveshead School. There is usually plenty of parking at the School but if there are lots of home fixtures it can get full. Your coach will let you know if it's going to be busy. Iveshead School do not allow dogs on site, alcohol, smoking or vaping. So please refrain from those activities. We are all volunteers and appreciate help setting up and removing the goals & corner flags at the end of matches.

Away Games

Details of away games are given by the team coach on WhatsApp, Spond or Fulltime. Any details the club wishes/needs to share with parents are also forwarded via this medium, please respect opposition rules on parking when at away fixtures and the FA RESPECT guidelines.

Game Time

At Shepshed Dynamo Y&J, we are proud to be an **inclusive club** where every player matters. Our aim is to ensure that all players enjoy fair opportunities to take part in matches, develop their skills, and play at a level that suits their ability. We recognise that this can be more challenging for teams with larger squads, but our commitment remains the same – to give every player the chance to play and grow.

For players up to and including **U13s**, we are dedicated to providing fair game time across matches. From **U14s and above**, when teams move into 11-a-side football, game time can depend on a wider range of factors such as player development, fitness, and match demands. In these age groups, coaches will always keep parents informed about team selection and playing time to ensure transparency and understanding.

Respect Rules

Please remember all coaches, support staff and officials are VOLUNTEERS and are not to be abused in any form. Players are of differing abilities and we expect encouragement rather than criticism. At all matches played during the football season, there will be a respect barrier along one side of the pitch being used. All parents and guardians are to remain behind the respect barrier while the match is taking place. A parents code of conduct can be found here: <u>Policies</u>

WhatsApp

Veo Camera Consent

Thanks to a generous contribution from our sponsor <u>Vetio</u>, Shepshed Dynamo Y&J have acquired two <u>Veo</u> video cameras, which enable the coaches to record and analyse matches. It also means the players and parents can watch the matches back. To ensure we follow safeguarding guidelines we ask all parents to opt in or out of the usage of the cameras and will plan our usage accordingly.
